

Foreword by the Principal

UCCKE is nine years old and it is still very young. Yet, with the blessings of the Lord, the school has achieved a lot in these past years. The school year 2011-12 was also a year of abundance and thanksgiving.

UCCKE continues to be a popular school in the community. About 1500 parents attended the two School Briefing Sessions. We were able to select 150 S1 students of good caliber from about 1150 applicants. At the same time, the S1 students also enjoyed the required live-in experience of the dormitory program very much.

This school year was a very special one with double cohorts of students, the last S7 HKAL class and the first S6 HKDSE class had to take the public examinations in the same year. Both cohorts have achieved good results. In particular, the S6 students had an outstanding performance and 50% of them received JUPAS offer, with two students admitted to the CUHK medical school. Nearly all S6 graduates have continued their tertiary study locally and overseas. This is a great encouragement to teachers and students.

Other than academic pursuit, the

school continued to provide a wide spectrum of other learning opportunities locally and overseas for students to enrich their life experience and widen their global perspectives.

Among the school activities, the Annual School Open Day has always been the special feature of the school life. In this school year, teachers, students and parents participated whole-heartedly from preparation all the way to the end of the event. Though the School Open Day only lasted for one day, the rich programs, the booths and the good turnout of students, parents with their family members, and visitors had turned the school into a boisterously hilarious and jubilant place. The PTA food court was the most popular place. Alumni often indicate that the School Open Day has been memorable part of their school life. Though they have graduated from the school, many would come back on this special day.

Furthermore, the students have won many prizes in the inter-school competitions, and the school is proud of their performance. In particular, I was delighted to learn that students did learn and grow a lot in the process of competitions, even

though they may not have won any prizes. This has been our school spirit, "process is more important than the results."

The school theme for the school year 2011-12 was "Find Us Faithful". As a whole, the school community did live up to this theme. We had different programs to encourage and guide students to be faithful in whatever they do, so that God would find us faithful. I am sure that this Annual Report can give you a glimpse of what students have done and have achieved as a community in this school year.

Lastly, I have to express my sincere gratitude to the members of the School Management Committee for their leadership and support given to me, my dedicated teachers for their unreserved effort, the beloved parents for their continuous support and my lovely students for their involvement in the schooling process during the school year of 2011-12. 1.1.4.4 Executive Committee

The Executive Committee is composed of the Principal, Vice-Principals, Form Coordinators and teachers of various functional responsibilities, with a total of 13 people. They met twice a month on Monday for about two hours to decide on the administrative matters of the school. Major changes were also discussed in these meetings and proposals were made to SMC for consideration and approval.

1.1.4.5 Department Management

The academic subjects are classified according to subject nature. There are eight faculties: Faculty of Chinese, English and Foreign Languages, Mathematics, Science and Computer Science, Humanities, Business, Life Education and Cultural Subjects. Subject panels report to the Faculty Heads who are under the Academic Coordinator. Other than the academic faculties, the school has functional departments that are led by Department Coordinators. They are Spiritual, Counseling and Disciplinary, Co-curricular Activities, Moral and Civic, Career Guidance, Student Affairs and Parent Affairs.

1.2. Staff Collaboration

1.2.1 Teaching Team

Our teaching body was composed of 72 full time teachers, 2 part time teachers, and 8 teaching assistants. All teachers possess at least a bachelor's degree, with 49% possess a Master's degree and 3% with Doctorate's degree. There were also 32 non-teaching staff who served in different support groups for teachers and school administration.

A weekly teachers meeting is held on Wednesday afternoon. In addition, the Executive Committee meeting minutes with announcements are delivered to all teachers. This weekly meeting is an important means to enhance effective communication and professional development.

1.2.2 Professional Development

As a Christian school, apart from academic related professional training, UCCKE encourages teachers to receive formal training in Christian school education. In the past summer, 2 teachers (Mr. Wan Chi Ho and Miss Wong Mei Po) have graduated from the Diploma in Christian Education, Research Institute For Christian Education.

An annual 2-day Retreat Camp was held for teachers (22-23/8/2012) in the Breakthrough Youth Village.

1.2.2.3 Professional Talks by our Teachers

1.3 Stakeholders' feedback

Stakeholders' questionnaires (teachers, parents, students) are administered once a year to collect feedback and opinion from the concerned parties. There would be a review on all the items in the questionnaires. Besides, students' feedback in each subject will be collected at the end of each term for teachers' self-evaluation. In general, stakeholders had positive comments to various aspects of the school.

1.3.1 Teacher

The weekly Executive Committee meeting and the weekly teachers meeting have been good channels for ongoing evaluation and feedback from teachers.

Every Wednesday is the school's Early Release Day. Teachers have made good use of the time for holding subject meetings and attend the Wednesday Teachers Prayer Meeting. Teachers were put in prayer partners groups for mutual spiritual support and they gathered to pray for the school, students and personal needs.



1.3.2 Parents

The eClass intranet has been a good channel for parents to communicate with the Principal and teachers. The School's monthly Parent-Teacher Happy Hour has also served as an occasion for immediate feedback and exchange of information. Many parents made good use of such channels as indicated in their active participation in the Parent-Teacher Happy Hour. They also demonstrated a very positive attitude towards home-school cooperation as shown in their response in the year-end questionnaire.



1.3.3 Students

Students had to complete a course evaluation form for each subject at the end of each term. Lesson observation and homework checking were also in place so that teachers would receive constructive feedback for further improvement. Students facing public examination were invited to attend Lunch Chat with the Principal. The morale of the S.5, S.6 and S.7 students was greatly enhanced through friendly chat with Dr. To.

- To produce a guide book for strategic life planning.

- To strengthen collaborations between UOCKE & universities at departments and subject levels to expose students to possible university life.

2. To devise effective strategies to help students cope with DSE and enhance their chances of getting into universities.

- Individualized counseling provided for S.6 students regarding DSE preparation and JUPAS subject choice.
- Effective use of students exam performance for the coordination of gifted education.

2.2 Core Subjects

2.2.1 English Language

For 2011-2012, the English Department has continued to experience the Lord's gracious blessings with 100% passing in both the HKAL Use of English and the HKDSE English Language public examinations. The UE results were the school's best with one A, five B and nine Cs. Likewise, the HKDSE fared impressively with two 5**, four 5*, twenty-two 5, fifty-two 4, thirty-six 3 and one 2. In addition, three students were awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the Speech Festival among 50 participants. Bettina Fung of S.3 was awarded 3rd runner up in the Hong Kong Schools Writing Contest senior group and the following three students received awards from the Gifted Education Section of the EDB for the Hong Kong Budding Poet Secondary Section: Brian Poon of S.1 came 3rd runner up and Poet of the School, Mervyn Chan Ming Hang of S.5 received a Commendation as did Jessica Wong Jing Man of S.2. Jessica Wong also won the Best Improviser of the Year (Secondary Section) award. We will do our best to live to the utmost for our Lord in this 10th UCCKE Anniversary year.

2.2.2 Mathematics

In 2011-2012, the Mathematics Department has been granted an EDB funding to launch a three years learning and teaching project: "We S.A.W. Why!" The project was practiced in S1. There has been a significant enhancement in students' problem solving skill. The department has also developed an effective assessment tool: "learning through assessment" with the support of EDB and Curriculum Development Council (CDC), The tool can really enhance students' creative thinking ability.

Besides, encouraging results were achieved in various kinds of mathematics competition. Eighteen students obtained distinction or high distinction in International Competitions and Assessments for Schools 2011; three students

obtained distinction or high distinction in Australian Mathematics Competition 2011.

2.2.3 Chinese Language Teaching

此外教育局校本支援組導師陳宇鋒先生亦以私人身份，協助中四、五級科任老師設計和優化「文化專題探討」和「新聞與報道」兩個選修單元，務求教學內容更切合學生的興趣和需要，學習更見效能。中一級亦與教育局資優教育組合作，在校推行資優教育教學單元，照顧學習差異，提升學習成果。

在初中級，與「巧、克、力網上學習平台」合作，我校學生全體參與「巧克力——寫作起革命」的網上寫作活動。學生普遍反應積極，熱衷寫作，優秀作品亦已印製成書，每位參加者皆獲得一本作品作紀念。

2.2.4 Liberal Studies

過去一年，本校通識教育科繼續獲得教育局校本支援計劃的協助，發展單元校本教材，有效的學與教及評估策略，以提升同學探究能力和培養同學多角度思考與批判性思考能力。

一如過去兩年，本科科任老師參與校外內不同的培訓課程，以提升對本科學與教的能力。校方亦為科組安排共同備課時段，讓老師進行教學上的交流。

學校亦為提升同學的學習水平，開設了通識教育科小組學習班，加強他們對單元議題的認識和答題技巧。此外，學校開設英語通識教育班，以照顧一些以英語為母語或英語能力較強的同學。

2.3 EDB Pilot Scheme on eLearning: We S.A.W. Why

UCCKE has been awarded a three-year pilot schools e-learning scheme for enhancing our teaching and learning. The project stresses collaborative knowledge construction through inquiry, reflection and formative assessment in an e-learning environment.

In order to facilitate an interactive learning classroom, we had purchased 17 sets of tablet PC, 32 pieces of ipad, an interactive response system and an interactive whiteboard. We had

also improved the electronic school management system to make the teaching flow effective.

2.4 Library as a Learning Centre

2.4.1 Explicit teaching of Library and Reading Skills

Presentation sessions were conducted for S1 - S3 classes during the Reading Time.



2.4.2 Extended Research

S1 students spent a couple of weeks researching on certain topics in the library with both printed and electronic resources. They had to apply reading and information skills that they have learned in the Library Program.

2.4.3 Electronic Resources Workshops

Regular seminars were conducted to introduce new resources to staff and workshops were held to teach students to use them.

2.5 Reading for Learning

2.5.1 Growing through Reading

S1– S3 Students read books on various subjects and levels appropriate to their reading ability, and then they were to submit their reflective sharings online through eClassroom. 232 students got the Gold Awards, i.e. with an Excellent Grade in one term and at least Good in the other two terms; 309 students got the Silver Awards, i.e. with Passes in all 3 terms and at least Good in two terms; 28 students got the Bronze Awards, i.e. with Passes in all 3 terms and at least Good in one term.

2.5.2 Reading Circles

S1 students in groups of 5 under the Reading Circles Mentors who were our senior form students met regularly to discuss the books that they were reading. These reading sessions were conducted in both Terms 2 & 3.

2.5.3 Book Week

S1 to S5 students participated in “No Media” week In October.

Students were encouraged to read instead of spending time on social networking.

Special guest speaker was invited to conduct book talk to students during the Book Week and the author of a teenage novel conducted writing workshops to students in different forms. Students were encouraged to participate in short story writing and reading quotes illustration competitions.

The winners' works were displayed in the library throughout the whole month.

They listened to the briefing conducted by the UCCKE IPSC team members and waited for the challenge during the stage sessions. Students from both UCC and UCCKE enjoyed the activity very much. UCCKE IPSC students learnt how to arrange a program and whole-heartedly commit to their part of service despite running a program smoothly could be quite difficult. All in all, they found the experience so meaningful. We hope the other teams and groups who have shared their expertise with other people in the name of God and God's name will be glorified through these social service.

School Ethos



3.1 National Education, Moral and Civic Education and HOM

A lot of whole school activities were carried out to reiterate the year theme "Find Us Faithful":

Activities to facilitate students' whole-person development were implemented. Concerning national education, there were a flag-raising ceremony, a speech about Basic Law, an inter-form competition and tours back to China during Easter Holidays. To raise students' awareness of social and global issues, there were board displays and morning announcements of social issues, mock Chief Executive Election, Campus Cleaning Campaign, Fruit Days, a talk related to teenagers, a sharing on anti-corruption and a visit to High Court.

To enhance students' good learning habits, there were teachings of Habits of Minds (HOM) skills. Students were encouraged to employ the different skills in their daily life. To acknowledge students with outstanding performances, HOM awards were given.

3.2 Discipline and Counseling

3.2.1 Striving for Excellence Campaign

The Discipline and Counseling team organized "Striving for Excellence" campaign to encourage students to be punctual to school and responsible in submitting their homework. The number of participants of the "Striving for Excellence" campaign in the three school terms was 381 (41%), 210 (28%), and 195 (26%) respectively. The participation rate was quite high. The proportion of participants who received awards was 65%, 60% and 54% respectively in the three terms.

3.2.2 Project Gabriel

Project Gabriel was a mentorship scheme in which students from upper forms (S.3 to S.5) had weekly lunch meetings with S.1 students in small groups. Through group activities, sharing and prayers, the upper form leaders (Gabriels) helped the S.1 students to adapt to secondary school life smoothly and provided them with support, guidance and assistance in both academic and whole-person development. An evaluation survey conducted at the end of the school year reflected

that the scheme was successful. Some of the statistics in the survey is extracted as follows:

- 56% of S.1 students strongly agreed with the statement, "I like my Gabriel."
- 47% of S.1 students strongly agreed with the statement, "My Gabriel was able to provide me with advice on my school life."
- 43% of S.1 students strongly agreed with the statement, "Project Gabriel helped me to transit to secondary school life."
- 56% of S.1 students strongly agreed with the statement, "My group members participated actively in the group sharing."



3.3 Nourishing the Spirituality of Students

Being a Christian school, we dedicate to inculcating our students with Christian values. The school's Spiritual Affairs Committee (SAC) has a variety of activities to reiterate the school year theme "Find Us Faithful". SAC has been working closely with the school church's pastoral team to strengthen students' faith. Whole year activities included Weekly Chapel, United Christian Fellowship, Student Prayer Meeting, Tuesday Café and so on.

In 2011-2012, SAC has launched the project Life and Death Education for F.5 students, through intra-subjects, seminars, workshops and different learning experiences outside classroom, students exposed to the issue of life and death, and at the same time, fostered indeed an understanding of "Hope", which is a value stressed in the bible. Moreover, the project is also helpful to students in building up a positive view of life, enhancing their ability to handle adverse circumstances and negative emotion.

3.4 School-Church Collaboration

United Christian Community Church is part of the school, founded to serve the school community (堂校一體化). The Church Council consists of the School Chaplain, the Principal, parents and teachers. The church has a congregation of about 170, mostly families of the School. The pastoral work of UCCC is mainly shared by the pastoral team — Rev. Dr. Hung Kwok Chi, Pastor Tam Wai Yee, Pastor Wong Pak Ming and Pastor Wong Tam Ka Man. They also taught in the school. UCCC closely works with the school's Spiritual Affairs Committee in various student ministries. Furthermore, UCCC also engages in parents ministries and regular activities, like Parents' Education Institute, Parent Fellowship, Prayer Meeting, Bible Study Class, Youth Fellowship, Adult Ministry, and Regular Sunday Teen Worship Service, etc.

Our Student Mission and Service Team aroused their schoolmates' concern through sharing in Assembly, campaigning for, or producing video about Child Sponsorship, Green Christmas, Local Food-Bank, and Respect to and co-work with Mentally Retarded. Our student group also participated Interschool Competition of “School of Caring Poverty – Poverty Project”, they splitted into 6 groups and won the Champion, 1st Runner Up, 3rd Runner Up, 5th Runner Up, and two Merit Prizes.

Being a faithful steward of God, we provided opportunities and guided students to value people, be a good partner of the community, commit to the poor, and be responsive to the needy.
