1. Learning activities/ workshops/ tasters on Chinese culture	\$36,000	A series of Chinese music lessons were organized in junior form music lessons. After two weeks of Chinese music culture lessons, 12 students formed an improvisation group with the pipa teacher and had their first performance in our Annual Concert in July 2024. Their understanding of Chinese music was enhanced through this collaboration as well as a workshop on Chinese and Western Ensemble Improvisation.
2. Organizing or subsidizing students for local or overseas joint-school activities or competitions	-----	Nil

Organizing or sponsoring students for local visit or field study	\$10,950.00	Students in S.3 and S.5 gained an in-depth understanding of the local history and stories through visits organized by the Chinese Department to Shatin, North Point, Wan Chai, and Aberdeen (Wah Fu Estate). They also had the opportunity to consolidate their learning through literary writing in various genres.

They gained a deeper understanding of Chinese culture through the trip.
