1. To organize or subsidize students' participation in diversified PE-/sports-related learning activities/ competitions	\$4,650.00	S.1 students were able to engage in diversified sports activities including fencing, rope skipping, archery and Tchoukball through the experiential sessions held in the OLE Day during post-exam period. They learnt basic skills of these sports through the professional training offered by the coaches.
2. To organize or subsidize the participation of students, teachers and coaches in PE-/sports-related exchange activities/study visits in the Mainland/overseas	\$10,276.38	Two overseas sports trips were organized in July 2024. The Archery Team advanced their skills through intensive training and competitions in Taiwan. Additionally, twelve students experienced equestrian sports during a four-day training trip in Mainland China. Both trips successfully enhanced skills and broadened students' sports experiences.
