1. To organise or subsidise the participation of students, teachers and coaches in PE-/sports-related exchange activities/study visits in the Mainland/overseas	\$12,373.64	Twenty members of the Boys and Girls Volleyball Team were subsidized for their trip to participate in a friendly match held at Pui Ching Middle School in Macau in April 2025. In addition to enhancing their volleyball skills, they also had the opportunity to build relationships and engage in meaningful exchanges with volleyball team players in Macau.
2. To purchase or upgrade sports equipment in the school	\$122,700.00	Dual-frequency RFID Chip Timing Gate HR2X-1000 system (雙頻RFID晶片計時閘HR2X-1000) has been purchased this year for all students. It has greatly enhanced the school's capacity to monitor and record students' cardiorespiratory endurance, particularly during the 9-minute fitness run and campus run. This allows observation of changes related to students' cardiorespiratory endurance fitness, enhancing their cardiorespiratory function capacity. This technology supports evidence-based evaluation of students' cardiorespiratory function, thus enabling targeted refinement of physical education and wellness programmes to support continual improvement in students' fitness and overall health.
